



Would you like to share your views on opioid medication, overdose and take-home naloxone?

If so, we would like to speak to you.

A new study based at Curtin University aims to explore personal experiences of opioid medication consumption and knowledge of take-home naloxone.

The study is open to anyone aged 18 and over.

People with past experiences are also encouraged to participate.

The purpose of the study is to gather information about experiences of taking opioid medication and your knowledge of take-home naloxone (a drug that reverses the effects of opioid overdose). We are keen to hear from you even if you haven't heard of take-home naloxone before. This research will help us develop an online information resource about take-home naloxone.

Participation involves a **confidential audio recorded interview** of about one hour, and you will be reimbursed \$50 for your time.

The interviews will be conducted in a location of your choice.
